Thank you for your email, received on 4 March 2016. You requested the following information, under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA):

"numbers of new build residential consents for each month from January 2014 to February this year.

For each month, I would like to know:

- The total number of residential building consents for new builds*
- The number of residential building consents for new builds with a consent value of less than \$250,000*
- What percentage of those total consents were for a new build with a consent value of less than \$250,000*
- What percentage of the total was for multiple units, rather than single dwellings*

If you can give me the consent value of every build in each month that would be very helpful, but if that is going to take a lot of time to compile don't worry about it."
